4. Title: Emergency Services and Disaster Law; local and inter-jurisdictional emergency

- 5. Summary: Current law requires each local and inter-jurisdictional agency to prepare and keep current a local or inter-jurisdictional emergency operations plan for its area. Such plans must include, be not be limited to, responsibilities of all local agencies and an established chain of command, and a provision that the Department of Criminal Justice Services and the Virginia Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund must be contacted immediately to deploy assistance in the event of an emergency as defined in the emergency response plan when there are victims as defined in § 19.2-11.01 (Crime victim and witness rights). Current law designates the Department of Criminal Justice Services and the Virginia Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund as the lead coordinating agencies for those individuals determined to be victims. This bill requires local and inter-jurisdictional agencies to include provisions in their emergency operations plans to ensure that such plans are applied equitably and that the needs of minority and vulnerable communities are met during emergencies.
