- 4. Title: Department of Education; School Construction Fund and Program.
- **5. Summary:** Establishes the School Construction Fund as a special non reverting fund in the state treasury and requires the Department of Education to establish the School Construction Program for the purpose of providing grants from the Fund, subject to certain conditions, to school boards that leverage federal, state, and local programs and resources to finance the design and construction of new school buildings and facilities or the modernization and maintenance of existing school buildings and facilities.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see Item 8.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The additional state cost for the School Construction Fund cannot be determined, as any cost is dependent on the amount of funding appropriated by the General Assembly for such grants.

The Department of Education (DOE) can absorb the cost of developing the School Construction Program but estimates it will require \$20,000 annually to support staff needed to administer the program.
