4. Title: Tourism Development Authority; name change.

5. Summary: Renames the Tourism Development Authority, also known as the Virginia Coalfield Regional Tourism Development Authority, as the Heart of Appalachia Tourism Authority. The bill establishes the Authority as a political subdivision, a body politic and corporate for the LENOWISCO and Cumberland Plateau Planning District Commissions. The bill contains technical amendments.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a state fiscal impact.
