4. Title: Department of Health; Department of Environmental Quality; pilot program; engineered septic systems.

5. Summary: That, subject to existing public health and water quality requirements, the Department of Health and Department of Environmental Quality shall authorize the Middle Peninsula Planning District Commission to initiate a three-year pilot program to analyze an engineered septic unit that houses and treats all sewage effluent in a vertically elevated, self-contained unit suitable for areas with high water tables and flooding in Coastal Virginia.
