**3. Committee:** Courts of Justice

**4. Title:** Substantial Risk Order Registry; maintenance and access.

**5. Summary:** Provides that an additional purpose of the Substantial Risk Order Registry, administered by the Department of State Police (VSP), is to monitor and evaluate the administration and effectiveness of §§ 19.2-152.13 (pertaining to emergency substantial risk orders) and 19.2-152.14 (pertaining to substantial risk orders). The bill provides that VSP must, for the purpose of (i) monitoring and evaluating the impact of these provisions on public safety and (ii) assessing the fairness of the administration of these provisions, make the Registry information available upon request to institutions of higher education and other research organizations or institutions in the Commonwealth. The information from the Registry may be combined with other data held by the Commonwealth to enable VSP to remove from the Registry the name and all personal identifying information of any person, and to release such information to research organizations in the Commonwealth.
