3. Committee: House Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Local electoral boards and general registrar; disclosure of certain gifts and funding.

5. Summary: Requires the disclosure of any gift, including money or services, given by a private individual, corporation, partnership, trust, or other third party to a local electoral board or an office of the general registrar. Such disclosure is required to be made to the clerk of the governing body within five days of receipt and shall include the amount or value of the gift, the date of receipt, and the name and address of the donor. The disclosed information shall be posted on the official website of the county or city. The bill provides that the disclosure requirements do not apply to money or services paid out of the budget of the locality or provided through the general appropriation act established by the General Assembly.
