**3. Committee:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

**4. Title:** Food and drink permit requirements.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services (the Commissioner), after conducting the required inspection, to issue a permit for the operation of any food manufacturer, food storage warehouse, or retail food establishment, and prohibits the operation of such food manufacturer, food storage warehouse, or retail food establishment without such permit. The bill authorizes the Commissioner to suspend such permits for certain violations and the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services to adopt regulations to administer the permitting process.
