3. Committee: Labor and Commerce

4. Title: Employment; disclosure of terms.

5. Summary: This bill requires every employer to furnish to its employees, at the time of the employee's hiring, a written disclosure of information regarding the terms of employment, including the name and address of the employer, the rate of pay and basis thereof, and the regular payday. The measure also requires employers to notify its employees in writing of any changes to this information.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI) indicates that it does not have enforcement responsibilities associated with this bill. However, the agency anticipates that this bill will result in a workload impact related to fielding calls regarding the requirements provided in the bill, which can be absorbed.
