4. Title: Education and workforce development; Virginia Works Portal created; report.

Summary: Creates the Virginia Works Portal, administered by the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority, to provide one-stop access to information regarding education pathways, career opportunities, and workforce development information available from agencies, institutions, and entities around the Commonwealth.

8. Fiscal Implications: As introduced, HB 30/ SB 30 includes \$6.1 million in the first year from the general fund for the integration of workforce case management systems. It is anticipated that the provisions of this bill would be covered by that appropriation if included in the Appropriation Act,
