- 6 A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-742.1, 46.2-742.2, 46.2-745.1, and 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 46.2-725.3, 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5, relating to special license plates; military decorations.
- 9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 10 1. That §§ 46.2-742.1, 46.2-742.2, 46.2-745.1, and 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia are amended 11 and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 46.2-725.3, 12 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5 as follows:
 - § 46.2-725.3. Special license plates for recipients of certain military decorations.

A. No special license plate for recipients of a military decoration shall be considered by the General
Assembly unless and until the person or entity seeking the authorization of such special plate has
demonstrated to the satisfaction of the General Assembly the order of precedence of such military
decoration as determined by the federal Department of Defense or other relevant federal agency.

B. Any special license plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Medal of Honor 18 and above the Purple Heart in order of precedence shall be authorized for issuance by the Department 19 20 with a \$10 one-time fee in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Any special license plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Purple Heart in the order of precedence 21 shall be authorized for issuance by the Department with a \$10 annual special license plate fee in 22 23 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Special license plates for recipients of the Purple Heart shall be issued as provided in § 46.2-742. The Department is authorized to issue an additional 24 25 plate reflecting the "V" for Valor for any plate currently issued by the Department reflecting a military decoration that the federal Department of Defense or other relevant federal agency has determined is 26 eligible for the "V" for Valor Device. The Department shall charge only the prescribed cost of state 27

28 license plates for any plate design reflecting the "V" for Valor Device.

C. Notwithstanding § 46.2-725, special license plates for the recipients of a military decoration are exempt from subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725. Unremarried surviving spouses of individuals eligible to receive such special license plates are also authorized to receive such special license plates.
§ 46.2-742.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Bronze Star, Bronze Star with a

§ 46.2-742.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Bronze Star, Bronze Star with a "V" for valor, or the Silver Star; fee.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded a Bronze Star, Bronze Star with a "V" for valor, or Silver Star Medal, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

For each set of license plates issued under this section, other than those that reflect the Bronze Star,
the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed cost of state license plates. For Bronze Star license plates,
the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee
of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

41 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of subsection **B** of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 42 plates issued under this section.

43 The design of license plates issued under this section to persons who have been awarded multiple44 decorations shall reflect the number of such decorations.

45 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section46 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

47 § 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished
48 Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the Distinguished Flying
49 Cross with a "V" for Valor.

50 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy 51 Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the 52 Distinguished Flying Cross with a "V" for Valor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special 53 license plates.

The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

56 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 57 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

58 The design of license plates issued under this section to persons who have been awarded multiple 59 decorations shall reflect the number of such decorations. 60 For each set of license plates issued under this section, other than those that reflect the Distinguished

61 Flying Cross, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed cost of state license plates. For 62 Distinguished Flying Cross license plates, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed

63 cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

§ 46.2-745.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the
 Airman's Medal, the Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal.

66 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services of the United 67 States that the applicant has been awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, *the Airman's Medal, the* 68 Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 69 such persons. No fee shall be charged for the issuance of these license plates under this section to any 70 one motor vehicle owned and used personally by any applicant. For each additional set of license plates 71 issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed fee for state 872 license plates. For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in

73 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are 74 issued.

- 75 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
 76 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
 77 for.
- 78 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under 79 this section.

80 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section81 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

82 § 46.2-745.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.

83 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
 84 applicant has been awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Commissioner shall issue
 85 special license plates to such persons and to unremarried surviving spouses of such persons.

For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time an annual fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

88 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
89 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
90 for.

91 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

93 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section94 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

95 § 46.2-745.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy
 96 Distinguished Service Medal, the Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force
 97 Distinguished Service Medal.

98 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
99 applicant has been awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy Distinguished Service Medal, the
100 Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force Distinguished Service Medal, the
101 Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

102 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

104 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and 105 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided 106 for.

107 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under **108** this section.

109 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section110 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

111 § 46.2-745.5. Special license plates for persons awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal 112 or the Defense Superior Service Medal.

113 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the 114 applicant has been awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal or the Defense Superior Service 115 Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

116 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

118 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and 119 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided 120 for.

121 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under

- 123 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section may also be issued special license plates under this section. 2. That all license plates issued pursuant to § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia prior 124

- to July 1, 2021, shall remain valid until their expiration and shall be renewed under the provisions 126
- 127 of § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia as they existed prior to July 1, 2021.
