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## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 24 of Title 2.2 an article numbered 29, 3 consisting of sections numbered 2.2-2499.1 through 2.2-2499.4, relating to establishment of the 4 Virginia LGBTQ+ Advisory Board.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 24 of Title 2.2 an article numbered 9 29, consisting of sections numbered 2.2-2499.1 through 2.2-2499.4, as follows: 10

Article 29.

# Virginia LGBTQ+ Advisory Board.

§ 2.2-2499.1. Virginia LGBTQ+ Advisory Board; membership; terms; quorum; meetings.

13 A. The Virginia LGBTQ+ Advisory Board (the Board) is established as an advisory board in the executive branch of state government. 14

15 B. The Board shall have a total membership of 26 members that shall consist of 21 nonlegislative 16 citizen members and five ex officio members. Nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed as 17 follows: 21 members, at least 15 of whom shall identify as LGBTQ+, to be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. The Secretaries of the Commonwealth, Commerce and 18 19 Trade, Education, Health and Human Resources, and Public Safety and Homeland Security, or their 20 designees, shall serve ex officio with nonvoting privileges. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Board 21 shall be citizens of the Commonwealth.

22 C. Ex officio members of the Board shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. 23 Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired terms. 24 Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. All members may be 25 reappointed.

26 Âfter the initial staggering of terms, nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for a term of 27 four years. No nonlegislative citizen member shall serve more than two consecutive four-year terms. The 28 remainder of any term to which a member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term in 29 determining the member's eligibility for reappointment.

30 D. The Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. A majority of 31 the members shall constitute a quorum. The meetings of the Board shall be held at the call of the 32 chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request. 33

## § 2.2-2499.2. Compensation; expenses.

34 Members shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be reimbursed for all reasonable 35 and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 36 2.2-2825. 37

### § 2.2-2499.3. Powers and duties of the Board; report.

38 The Board shall have the power and duty to:

39 1. Advise the Governor regarding the development of economic, professional, cultural, educational, 40 and governmental links between the Commonwealth and the LGBTQ+ community in Virginia.

41 2. Undertake studies, sponsor symposiums, conduct research, and prepare factual reports in order to 42 gather information to formulate and present recommendations to the Governor relating to issues of 43 concern and importance to the LGBTQ+ community in the Commonwealth.

44 3. Advise the Governor as needed regarding any statutory, regulatory, or other issues of importance 45 to the LGBTQ+ community in the Commonwealth.

4. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from public, quasi-public, or private 46 47 sources, including any matching funds as may be designated in an appropriation act, to enable it to **48** better carry out its objectives.

49 5. Submit an annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly for publication as a report 50 document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports. 51

§ 2.2-2499.4. Staffing. 52

53 The Office of the Governor shall provide staff support to the Board. All agencies of the 54 Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Board, upon request.

55 2. That the initial appointments of nonlegislative citizen members to the Virginia LGBTQ+ 56 Advisory Board shall be staggered as follows: five members for a term of one year, five members HB2130ER

57 for a term of two years, five members for a term of three years, and six members for a term of 58 four years.
