5 WHEREAS, Shenandoah University, a venerable institution of higher education in Winchester, has
7 provided an invaluable service to the community by serving as a distribution site for the COVID-19
8 vaccine; and

9 WHEREAS, in partnership with Valley Health and the Lord Fairfax Health District of the Virginia
10 Department of Health, Shenandoah University has converted its James R. Wilkins, Jr. Athletics &
11 Events Center, a 77,000-square-foot indoor athletic facility that is the largest space within 70 miles of
12 Winchester, into a mass-vaccination clinic for residents in the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, Shenandoah University opened its vaccination clinic on January 12, 2021, and has
 already enabled thousands of citizens of the Commonwealth to protect themselves and their loved ones
 from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Shenandoah University will make its facilities available 12 hours per day, allowingapproximately 1,200 to 1,500 individuals to be vaccinated daily; and

18 WHEREAS, several members of Shenandoah University's faculty and staff have contributed to the
 19 COVID-19 vaccine rollout, underscoring the institution's deep-rooted commitments to the community;

WHEREAS, by coming to the aid of the Commonwealth during this historic public health crisis,
 Shenandoah University demonstrates a collective spirit and sense of purpose that is an inspiration to all
 Virginians; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That Shenandoah University hereby be commended for its
 efforts to eliminate COVID-19 in the Commonwealth; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution
 for presentation to representatives of Shenandoah University as an expression of the House of Delegates'

28 admiration for the school's service to the Commonwealth.
