4. Title: Additional powers of the Commissioner during a state of emergency.

5. Summary: This proposal is to authorize the Commissioner, when a state of emergency has been declared by the Governor, to extend the validity or delay the cancellation of driver's licenses, special identification cards, and vehicle registrations, to extend the time frame during which a driver improvement clinic or payment plan must be completed, to extend the time frame during which new residents are required to obtain Virginia driver's licenses and to register vehicles for the duration of a declared state of emergency and for up to 90 days after the declaration of a state of emergency has been rescinded or expires.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is unaware of any fiscal impact related to this proposal. DMV will collect all relevant fees and payments once the extension period is over. The internal IT processes necessary to implement this legislation are currently being performed as this legislation has already been authorized pursuant to budget amendments authorized during the 2020 Special Session. The work can be performed using existing agency staff and resources.
