3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Naming U.S. Route 29; county manager plan of government.

5. Summary: Authorizes the board of any locality that has adopted the county manager plan of government (Arlington County) to name any section of U.S. Route 29 located within the boundaries of the locality. The bill provides that the Virginia Department of Transportation will place and maintain appropriate signs that will be paid for by the locality.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact to the Virginia Department of Transportation. The bill provides that the costs of any necessary signage would be paid for by the locality.
