**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Commercial driver's licenses, compliance.

**5. Summary:** Amends the Code of Virginia to require a lifetime disqualification for a commercial driver's license holder if the person is convicted of a felony involving a serious act or practice of human trafficking while operating a commercial motor vehicle. This legislation also removes the statutory prohibition on Class A driver training schools administering the CDL knowledge test and prohibits the courts and the Department of Motor Vehicle from masking convictions in compliance with federal regulation.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** DMV anticipates a fiscal impact of \$7,368 associated with IT programming. The work can be performed using existing agency staff and resources. There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the courts system.
