Section 46.2-325 currently requires that a licensee offering online driver education courses be licensed as a "computer-based driver education provider." This licensure requires that business entities, in addition to being licensed as Class B licensees have an online curriculum that is approved by the Department of Education. Typically, computer-based driver education providers offer the complete driver education program, including the classroom and behind-the-wheel components, and are administering the skills tests required to receive a driver's license.

Occasionally there are businesses that wish to provide the Virginia Driver's Manual Course, an 8-hour course offered to students who have failed the knowledge or skills examinations multiple times, or adults who wish to get a refresher on the basics prior to taking a skills or knowledge test. No examination is administered and this is not a curriculum that is governed by the Department of Education.
