4. Title: Student driver safety.

5. Summary: Adopts measures aimed at improving student driver safety. The bill requires the driver education program to include instruction concerning the dangers of distracted driving and speeding. The bill also requires that a student show proof of a valid driver's license or driver privilege card before being issued a school parking pass at a public high school and that schools use a common application for such parking passes.
