4. Title: Use of certain oriented strand board

5. Summary: The substitute bill prohibits the use by any person, local government, or agency of the Commonwealth of Class A fuel materials that contain oriented strand board, defined in the bill, during live fire training activities.

No provision of the bill restricts the manufacture, sale, use, or distribution of Class A fuel materials that contain oriented strand board for purposes outside of fire training activities.
