4. Title: Substantial Risk Order Registry; maintenance and access.

5. Summary: Provides that the Department of State Police (VSP) may make information from the Substantial Risk Order Registry available upon request to institutions of higher education and other research organizations or institutions in the Commonwealth. VSP must remove the names and other personal identifying information from such data before it is released to the institution of higher education, research organization or other institution.
