4. Title: Local special events license

5. Summary: The substitute bill would allow the Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority Board to increase the frequency and duration of special events, after adoption of an ordinance by a locality requesting such increase in frequency and duration. Such ordinance must include the size and scope of the area within which such special events will be held, a public safety plan, and any other considerations deemed necessary by the Board.

Fiscal Implications: According to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority (ABC), ABC existing special agents would issue any modifications to the frequency and duration of local special event licenses to localities.
