**4. Title:**    State Corporation Commission; issuance or renewal of insurance licenses during an emergency.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes the State Corporation Commission to temporarily suspend, authorize extensions of time, or waive requirements for the issuance or renewal of licenses or registrations related to insurance in the event of an emergency by order of 120 days' duration unless renewed by the Commission.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** State Corporation Commission Bureau of Insurance

**11. Other comments:** Senate Bill 1255 was introduced by its patron at the request of the State Corporation Bureau of Insurance to give the Commission the limited ability to waive certain rules on a temporary basis to assist candidates for insurance examinations or insurance agents needing more time to satisfy requirements in the event of an emergency. The amendment to the engrossed version of the bill specifies that the Commission's emergency order would be 120 days unless renewed by the Commission.
