12	1. § 1. That the Department of Medical Assistance Services (the Department) shall study options for and
	develop a plan to implement a process by which recipients of medical assistance services shall receive
13 14	payments, in the form of a voucher or electronic benefit transfer card, that may be used to purchase
15	over-the-counter medications and medical supplies prescribed by an authorized prescriber directly in a
16	retail setting. Such plan shall include identification of any statutory, regulatory, budgetary, or policy
17	changes and any federal approvals necessary to implement such plan, as well as an estimate of the
18	fiscal impact of implementation of the plan. The Department shall report its findings and plan to the
19	Governor and the Chairmen of the House Committees on Appropriations and Health, Welfare and
20	Institutions and the Senate Committees on Finance and Appropriations and Education and Health by
21	October 1, 2022.
