10 11	<b>Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:</b> <b>1.</b> § 1. That the Board of Pharmacy shall adopt regulations related to work environment requirements
12	for pharmacy personnel that protect the health, safety, and welfare of patients. Such regulations shall
13	include provisions (i) addressing sufficient pharmacy staffing to prevent fatigue, distraction, or other
14	conditions that interfere with a pharmacist's ability to practice with competence and safety; (ii) stating
15	standards for uninterrupted rest periods and meal breaks for pharmacy personnel; (iii) stating standards
16	that ensure adequate time for pharmacists to complete professional duties and responsibilities, including
17 18	drug utilization reviews, immunization administration, patient counseling, and verification of prescription accuracy; and (iv) limiting external factors such as productivity or production quotas to the extent that
19	such factors interfere with the ability to provide appropriate professional services to the public.
20	2. That [ an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
21	3. That the Board of Pharmacy's initial adoption of regulations necessary to implement the
22	provisions of this act shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq. of
23 24	the Code of Virginia), except that the Board of Pharmacy shall provide an opportunity for public
24 25	comment on the regulations prior to adoption of such regulations.

4. That the Board of Pharmacy shall amend and promulgate regulations in accordance with this act by September 1, 2022 the Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this act to be effective within 280 days of its enactment ]. 25 26 27 28
