234567 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-473.2, relating to covering a security camera in a correctional facility; penalty. 8

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-473.2 as follows: 9

10 § 18.2-473.2. Covering a security camera in a correctional facility; penalty.

A. As used in this section, "security camera" means an analog or digital photographic or video camera or other device capable of recording or transmitting a photograph, motion picture, or other 11 12 digital image that has been installed in a state or local correctional facility or any juvenile correctional 13 14 center.

15 B. Any person who intentionally covers, removes, damages, renders inoperable, or otherwise 16 obscures a security camera without the permission of the sheriff, jail superintendent, warden, or 17 Director of the Department of Corrections or Department of Juvenile Justice is guilty of a Class 1 18 misdemeanor.

19 C. Any person who intentionally covers, removes, damages, renders inoperable, or otherwise 20 obscures a security camera with the intent of inhibiting or preventing a security camera from recording 21 or transmitting a photograph, motion picture, or other digital image of the commission of a felony is 22 guilty of a Class 6 felony.

23 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 24 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the 25 necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 552 of the Acts of Assembly of 2021, Special Session I, 26 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of 27 28 \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary 29 appropriation cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department 30 of Juvenile Justice.
