HOUSE BILL NO. 160

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on General Laws

on February 8, 2022)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Mundon King)

amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 55.1-1209.1, relating to the Residential Landlord and Tenant Act; employees of the landlord; rental dwelling unit keys tronic kev codes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 55.1-1209.1 as follows:
- § 55.1-1209.1. Employees of the landlord; rental dwelling unit keys and electronic key codes; policies and procedures.
- A. As used in this section, "key" means any physical or electronic mechanism used to gain access to a rental dwelling unit.
- B. Any landlord who owns (i) more than four rental dwelling units in the Commonwealth or (ii) more than a 10 percent interest, either individually or through a business entity, in more than four rental dwelling units in the Commonwealth shall establish:
- 1. A policy requiring any applicant for employment in any position that will have access to keys for each rental dwelling unit to be subject to a pre-employment criminal history records check; and
- 2. Written policies and procedures regarding the (i) storage, issuance and return, and security of; (ii) access to; and (iii) if applicable, usage and deactivation of rental dwelling unit keys and electronic kev codes.
- C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) a financial institution, as defined in § 6.2-100, or (ii) any person who is a real estate licensee pursuant to Chapter 21 (§ 54.1-2100 et seq.) of Title 54.1.
