6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 54.1-2014 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Real Estate Appraises
7	Board; continuing education to include fair housing or appraisal bias.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 54.1-2014 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 54.1-2014. Continuing education.
11	The Board may establish in regulations requirements for continuing education as a prerequisite to
12	renewal of a license issued under this chapter. If the Board requires continuing education, the
13	requirements shall include a minimum of two hours of fair housing or appraisal bias courses.
14	2. That the Real Estate Appraiser Board (the Board) shall promulgate regulations to implement
15	the provisions of this act that include a course of at least two hours relating to fair housing or
16	appraisal bias. The Board's initial adoption of regulations necessary to implement the provisions of
17	this act shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq. of the Code of
18	Virginia), except that the Board shall provide an opportunity for public comment on the
19	regulations prior to adoption.
20	3. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2023.
