11 1. § 1. The Department of Transportation shall propose to the Federal Highway Administration and the Special Committee on U.S. Route Numbering of the American Association of State Highway and

1. U.S. Route 60 shall run concurrently with Interstate 64 from Exit 50 (Lexington/Kerr's Creek) to	
14 1. U.S. Route 60 shall run concurrently with Interstate 64 from Exit 50 (Lexington/Kerr's Creek) to 15 Exit 55 (Lexington/Virginia Horse Center) and concurrently with U.S. Route 11 from Exit 55	
(Lexington/Virginia Horse Center) of Interstate 64 to the intersection with existing U.S. Route 60 in	
downtown Lexington.	
2. That portion of existing U.S. Route 60 between Exit 50 (Lexington/Kerr's Creek) of Interstate 64	
to the intersection with U.S. Route 11 shall be renamed U.S. Route 850.
