12	§ 40.1-28.001. Medical mandate.
13	A. For the purposes of this section, "medical mandate" means any requirement by an employer for
14	an employee to undergo or participate in a health-related test, procedure, tracking or monitoring
15	program, or bodily insertion or injection of any drug.
16	B. An employee shall have a civil cause of action against his employer for any adverse reaction or
17	injury sustained by reason of a medical mandate issued by the employer as a condition of employment.
