The Secretary shall propose recommendations to 14 15 address any such laws, regulations, or policies; 2. Work with the Department of Labor and Industry to promote commercial driver's license (CDL) 16 17 training and certification opportunities among the workforce in the Commonwealth; 3. Work with the Department of Veterans Services to promote CDL training and certification 18 19 opportunities for veterans and military service members; 20 4. Work with the Department of Corrections to promote CDL training and certification opportunities 21 for individuals who are preparing to reenter society or who have already reentered society; 22 5. Coordinate with third parties, such as public institutions of higher education and private 23 businesses, to increase the number of training and testing opportunities for CDL applicants and 24 licensees, and to expand existing training where possible; 25 6.
