11	1. That § 17.1-917 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 17.1-917. Assistance and information; complaint forms.
13	A. State and local public bodies and departments, officers and employees thereof, and officials and
14	all personnel of the courts of the Commonwealth shall cooperate with and give reasonable assistance and
15	information to the Commission and any authorized representative thereof _{$\frac{1}{7}$} in connection with any
16	investigations or proceedings within the jurisdiction of the Commission.
17	B. Any standardized form developed and utilized by the Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission for
18	the filing of a complaint shall be made available to the public in paper form in every clerk's office in
19	all courts of the Commonwealth. In all state courts within the Commonwealth a sign shall be posted in
20	a location accessible to the public that notes the availability and location of such paper forms in the
21	office. Such signs shall also provide instructions to obtain a downloadable electronic version that shall
22	be made available through the official website of the judicial system of the Commonwealth, every
23	individual appellate, circuit, general district, and juvenile and domestic relations district court website,

if such website exists, and the website for the Division of Legislative Services.
