Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

1. That § 22.1-9 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 7 8

§ 22.1-9. Appointment, terms, and vacancies.

9 The Board of Education shall consist of nine members appointed by the Governor, at least two of 10 whom shall represent business and industry in the private sector in the Commonwealth, and of the nine members at least five shall reside in different superintendent's regions in the Commonwealth. The 11 Governor shall consider appointing one member with expertise or experience in local government 12 13 leadership or policymaking, one member with expertise or experience in career and technical education, 14 and one member with expertise or experience in early childhood education. Every appointment to the 15 Board shall be for a term of four years, except that appointments to fill vacancies other than by expiration of term shall be for the unexpired terms. All appointments, including those to fill vacancies, 16 shall be subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, and any appointment made during the recess 17 of the General Assembly shall expire at the end of 30 days after the commencement of the next session 18 of the General Assembly. No member of the Board shall be appointed to more than two consecutive 19 20 four-year terms.
