That § 32.1-162.9 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 32.1-162.9. Licenses required; renewal thereof. 12 A. No person shall establish or operate a home care organization without a license issued pursuant to 13 14 this article unless he is exempt from licensure pursuant to § 32.1-162.8. No license to establish or operate a home care organization shall be issued to any person who has been sanctioned pursuant to 42 15 16 U.S.C. § 1320a-7b. 17 B. The Commissioner shall issue or renew a license to establish or operate a home care organization upon application therefor on a form and accompanied by a fee prescribed by the Board if the 18 19 Commissioner finds that the home care organization is in compliance with the provisions of this article 20 and regulations of the Board, unless the Commissioner determines that no reciprocal agreement for the 21 licensing of home care organizations has been entered into by the Commonwealth with the state in 22 which the applicant resides or with the state in which the applicant's home care organization is licensed 23 to operate. The Commissioner shall not issue or renew a license to establish or operate a home care 24 organization to any applicant who has been sanctioned pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1320a-7b. 25 C. Any licensed home care organization may establish one or more branch offices serving portions of the total geographic area served by the licensee, provided that each branch office operates under the 26 27 supervision and administrative control of the licensee. The address of each branch office at which 28 services are provided by the licensee shall be submitted to the Department and included on any license 29 issued to the licensee. Branch offices shall be operated under the initial license issued to the home care 30 organization and shall not be required to obtain an additional license. Upon receipt of notice that a home 31 care organization has established a branch office that meets the criteria set forth in this subsection, the 32 Department shall issue an updated license including the address of the newly established branch office to 33 the home care organization within 10 business days. 34 D. Every applicant for an initial license to establish or operate a home care organization shall include 35

as part of his application proof of initial reserve operating funds in an amount determined by the Board, which shall be sufficient to ensure operation of the home care organization for the three-month period 36 37 after a license to operate has been issued. Such funds may include cash, cash equivalents that are readily 38 convertible to known amounts of cash and that present insignificant risk of change in value, borrowed 39 funds that are immediately available to the applicant, or a line of credit that is immediately available to 40 the applicant. Proof of funds sufficient to meet the requirements of this subsection shall include a 41 current balance sheet demonstrating availability of cash or cash equivalents, including all borrowed 42 funds, sufficient to meet the requirement for initial reserve operating funds together with a letter from 43 the officer of the bank or other financial institution where the funds are held or a letter of credit from a lender demonstrating the current availability of a line of credit and the amount thereof. 44 45

E. Every such license shall expire on the *third* anniversary of its issuance or renewal.

F. The activities and services of each applicant for issuance or renewal of a home care organization 46 47 license shall be subject to an inspection or examination by the Commissioner to determine if the home care organization is in compliance with the provisions of this article and regulations of the Board. **48** 49

G. No license issued pursuant to this article may be transferred or assigned.

50 H. Upon renewal of a license, the Department shall not require a home care organization to submit financial documents other than those required for initial licensure. 51

[ 2. That the fee for renewal of a home care organization license shall be \$1,500 until such time as 52

53 the Board of Health may amend or repeal regulations for the licensure of home care organizations 54 (12VAC5-381) of the Virginia Administrative Code. ]
