VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.2-1604 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the 3 Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity; definitions; small business.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That §§ 2.2-1604 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 2.2-1604. Definitions. 9

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

10 "Certification" means the process by which (i) a business is determined to be a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business or (ii) an employment services organization, for the purpose of reporting 11 12 small, women-owned, and minority-owned business and employment services organization participation in state contracts and purchases pursuant to §§ 2.2-1608 and 2.2-1610. 13

14 "Department" means the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity or any division of the 15 Department to which the Director has delegated or assigned duties and responsibilities.

"Employment services organization" means an organization that provides community-based 16 employment services to individuals with disabilities that is an approved Commission on Accreditation of 17 Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) accredited vendor of the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative 18 19 Services.

20 "Historically black colleges and university" includes any college or university that was established prior to 1964; whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans; and that is 21 accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary of 22 23 Education.

24 "Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 25 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

26 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and 27 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, 28 29 Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China, 30 Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana Islands, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of 31 the Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka, and who is regarded as such by the community of 32 which this person claims to be a part.

33 3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of 34 Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and 35 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America 36 37 and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is 38 recognized by a tribal organization.

39 "Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more 40 minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, 41 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership 42 interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or 43 more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals, or any historically black 44 45 college or university, regardless of the percentage ownership by minority individuals or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, the equity ownership interest in the 46 corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity. 47

'Small business" means a business that is at least 51 percent independently owned and controlled by **48** 49 one or more individuals, or in the case of a cooperative association organized pursuant to Chapter 3 (§ 13.1-301 et seq.) of Title 13.1 as a nonstock corporation, is at least 51 percent independently 50 controlled by one or more members, who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens and, together with 51 affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged 52 53 over the previous three years. One or more of the individual owners or members shall control both the 54 management and daily business operations of the small business.

55 "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other 56 unit of state government. "State agency" does not include any county, city, or town.

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57 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women 58 who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited 59 liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is owned by one or 60 more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business 61 operations are controlled by one or more women.

62 § 2.2-4310. Discrimination prohibited; participation of small, women-owned, minority-owned, and service disabled veteran-owned businesses and employment services organizations. 63

64 A. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, age, 65 66 disability, status as a service disabled veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to 67 discrimination in employment. Whenever solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by the Department of Small Business and Supplier 68 69 Diversity, which list shall include all companies and organizations certified by the Department.

70 B. All public bodies shall establish programs consistent with this chapter to facilitate the participation of small businesses, businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans, and employment services organizations in procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in 71 72 73 writing and shall comply with the provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by 74 the Governor pursuant to subsection C or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing 75 body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. 76 State agencies shall submit annual progress reports on (i) small, women-owned, and minority-owned 77 business procurement, (ii) service disabled veteran-owned business procurement, and (iii) employment 78 services organization procurement to the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity in a form 79 specified by the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity. Contracts and subcontracts awarded to employment services organizations and service disabled veteran-owned businesses shall be 80 credited toward the small business, women-owned, and minority-owned business contracting and subcontracting goals of state agencies and contractors. The Department of Small Business and Supplier 81 82 83 Diversity shall make information on service disabled veteran-owned procurement available to the 84 Department of Veterans Services upon request.

85 C. Whenever there exists (i) a rational basis for small business or employment services organization enhancement or (ii) a persuasive analysis that documents a statistically significant disparity between the 86 availability and utilization of women-owned and minority-owned businesses, the Governor is authorized 87 88 and encouraged to require state agencies to implement appropriate enhancement or remedial measures 89 consistent with prevailing law. Any enhancement or remedial measure authorized by the Governor 90 pursuant to this subsection for state public bodies may allow for small businesses certified by the 91 Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity or a subcategory of small businesses established as 92 a part of the enhancement program to have a price preference over noncertified businesses competing for the same contract award on designated procurements, provided that the bid of the certified small business or the business in such subcategory of small businesses established as a part of an enhancement 93 94 95 program does not exceed the low bid by more than five percent.

96 D. In awarding a contract for services to a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business that is 97 certified in accordance with § 2.2-1606, or to a business identified by a public body as a service 98 disabled veteran-owned business where the award is being made pursuant to an enhancement or remedial 99 program as provided in subsection C, the public body shall include in every such contract of more than 100 \$10,000 the following:

101 "If the contractor intends to subcontract work as part of its performance under this contract, the 102 contractor shall include in the proposal a plan to subcontract to small, women-owned, minority-owned, 103 and service disabled veteran-owned businesses."

104 E. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no state agency, department, or institution shall 105 discriminate against a bidder or offeror because the bidder or offeror employs ex-offenders unless the 106 state agency, department, or institution has made a written determination that employing ex-offenders on 107 the specific contract is not in its best interest. 108

F. As used in this section:

109 "Employment services organization" means an organization that provides community-based 110 employment services to individuals with disabilities that is an approved Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) accredited vendor of the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative 111 112 Services.

"Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 113 114 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

115 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and 116 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, 117

4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is recognized by a tribal organization.

"Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more 128 129 minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, 130 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership 131 interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and 132 133 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals, or any historically black college or university as defined in § 2.2-1604, regardless of the percentage ownership by minority 134 135 individuals or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, the 136 equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity.

"Service disabled veteran" means a veteran who (i) served on active duty in the United States
military ground, naval, or air service, (ii) was discharged or released under conditions other than
dishonorable, and (iii) has a service-connected disability rating fixed by the United States Department of
Veterans Affairs.

141 "Service disabled veteran business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or 142 more service disabled veterans or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company 143 or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or 144 liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are service disabled 145 veterans and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more 146 individuals who are service disabled veterans.

"Small business" means a business, independently owned and controlled by one or more individuals,
or in the case of a cooperative association organized pursuant to Chapter 3 (§ 13.1-301 et seq.) of Title
13.1 as a nonstock corporation, controlled by one or more members, who are U.S. citizens or legal
resident aliens, and together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or annual gross receipts of \$10
million or less averaged over the previous three years. One or more of the individual owners or
members shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small business.

153 "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other154 unit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town.

155 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women 156 who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited 157 liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is owned by one or 158 more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business 159 operations are controlled by one or more women.
