- 234567 A BILL to amend and reenact § 44-146.29:3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Emergency Shelters Upgrade Assistance Grant Fund. 8
 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That § 44-146.29:3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 44-146.29:3. Emergency Shelters Upgrade Assistance Grant Fund. 10

There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Emergency Shelters Upgrade Assistance Grant Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund 11 12 shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any 13 gifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state 14 treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and 15 16 be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal 17 year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the purposes of providing matching funds to localities or entities previously outlined in a local 18 shelter plan to install, maintain, or repair infrastructure for backup energy generation for emergency 19 20 shelters, including solar energy generators, and improve the hazard-specific structural integrity of shelter 21 facilities owned by the locality or identified in the shelter plan of the locality. Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the 22 Comptroller upon written request signed by the Director of Emergency Management or, if designated, 23 24 the State Coordinator of Emergency Management.

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
