6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1.** § 1. *That the Common Interest Community Board (the Board) shall review the feasibility of allowing*  
8 *audio and video recordings to be submitted with a notice of final adverse decision as a record pertinent*  
9 *to the decision in accordance with § 54.1-2354.4 of the Code of Virginia. In conducting its review, the*  
10 *Board shall (i) solicit and consider public comments; (ii) identify pertinent statutory and regulatory*  
11 *amendments necessary to allow for the submission of audio and video recordings in accordance with the*  
12 *provisions of this act; (iii) identify any impediments to the submission of audio and video recordings,*  
13 *including information technology limitations and compliance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom*  
14 *of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) and other public records laws; and (iv)*  
15 *consider whether allowing the submission of audio and video recordings pursuant to the provisions of*  
16 *this act would assist the Common Interest Community Ombudsman in the performance of his duties with*  
17 *respect to any notice of final adverse decision.*

18 *The Board shall report its findings and any legislative, regulatory, policy, or budgetary*  
19 *recommendations to the Secretary of Labor and the Chairmen of the House Committee on General Laws*  
20 *and the Senate Committee on General Laws and Technology on or before November 1, 2022.*
