| 12 | Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development listing each student's 9-1-1 address that |
| 13 | does not have broadband access, as defined by the broadband guidelines set out by the Virginia |
| 14 | Department of Housing and Community Development for its Virginia Telecommunication Initiative. Each |
| 15 | school board shall submit such annual report no later than December 31 of each such school year. The |
| 16 | Virginia Department of Education, in consultation with the Virginia Department of Housing and |
| 17 | Community Development, shall develop and publish no later than September 1, 2022, and may update |
| 18 | annually thereafter a framework and survey tool for school boards to submit such report and the data |
| 19 | contained therein. |
