6	A BILL to direct the Department of Criminal Justice Services to make recommendations on the
7	resentencing of persons convicted of marijuana-related offenses.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Criminal Justice Services shall make recommendations regarding the
10	resentencing of persons convicted of marijuana-related offenses committed prior to July 1, 2021, who
11	remain incarcerated for such conviction or a combination of such convictions or remain on community
12	supervision for such conviction or a combination of such convictions. The Department of Criminal
13	Justice Services shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly a report of its recommendations
14	by November 1, 2022. The report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of
15	Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and shall be posted on the
16	General Assembly's website.
