**5. Summary:** Provides that violations of existing provisions regarding tow truck drivers and towing and recovery operators are subject to the Virginia Consumer Protection Act. The bill repeals the \$150 civil penalty for certain towing violations in Planning District 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law indicates this bill presents no fiscal impact.
