Summary:** Exempts individuals and entities that donate food and charitable organizations that accept food donations from criminal and civil liability for donating or receiving commercially processed food past its best-by date or sell-by date as long as the food meets all labeling and date requirements, or date-marked prepared foods are not past the marked disposition date. The bill provides that immunity from liability shall not apply in instances of gross negligence or intentional misconduct.
