3. Committee: Committee Referral Pending

4. Title: Dangerous weapons; carrying to place of religious worship.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation repeals the prohibition on the carrying of dangerous weapons in a place of worship without good and sufficient reason while a meeting for religious purposes is being held at such place, which is currently punishable as a Class 4 misdemeanor.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item 8 below).

8. Fiscal Implications: A Class 4 misdemeanor is punishable by a fine of up to \$250. All revenue collected from such fines are deposited into the Literary Fund. The fiscal impact as a result of the proposed legislation cannot be determined at this time.
