- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services estimates that the scope of this work would likely require a temporary staff worker to conduct focus groups, manage research and analysis, and complete the report. They estimate this cost at \$15,000. In an agency as large as DBHDS, this level of cost is typically assumed to be able to be absorbed in an existing administrative budget. However, if a large number of bills become law with a requirement that DBHDS form workgroups and promulgate or modify regulations, then there will be a need for resources to handle the increase in workload.
