4. Title: Permanent protective orders; contact between petitioner and respondent.

Summary: The bill substitute amends the provisions of protective orders to provide an affirmative defense to the prosecution for violating a protective order when the petitioner initiated or instigated contact with the respondent and the respondent subsequently violated a condition imposed on him in response to such initiated or instigated conduct.
