Summary:** Exempts nursing homes from the requirement that applicants for a certificate of public agree to provide a specified level of charity care to indigent persons or accept patients requiring specialized care, facilitate the development and operation of primary and specialty medical care services in designated medically underserved areas of the applicant's service area, or both.
