1. Bill Number: SB362

House of Origin Introduced Substitute Engrossed

2. Patron: Stuart

3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Bicycles and certain other vehicles; riding two abreast.

5. Summary: Prohibits persons riding bicycles, electric personal assistive mobility devices, electric power-assisted bicycles, or motorized skateboards or scooters riding two abreast from impeding the normal and reasonable movement of traffic and requires such persons to move into a single-file formation as quickly as is practicable when being overtaken from the rear by a faster-moving vehicle. However, the failure to move into a single-file formation shall not constitute negligence per se in any civil action.
