**4. Title:** Children's Services Act; parent representatives; community policy and management teams.

Summary:** The substitute bill removes the provisions that such parent representatives who are employed by a public or private program that receives funds pursuant to the law or agencies represented on a family assessment and planning team may serve as a parent representative provided that they do not, as a part of their employment, interact directly on a regular and daily basis with children or supervise employees who interact directly on a regular basis with children.
