**4. Title:** Certain emergency and quarantine orders; additional procedural requirements.

**5. Summary:** The substitute bill provides that all of the rights, protections, and procedures of Article 3.02 (§ 32.1-48.05 et seq.) of Chapter 2 of Title 32.1 (governs quarantine and isolation of persons with communicable diseases of public health threat) apply in cases in which the Governor has issued an emergency order that includes any measure that closes schools or businesses or restricts the movement of healthy persons within the area to which the order applies.
