Fiscal Implications: This bill gives the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law (OAG) the power to establish the Operation Ceasefire Grant Fund (Fund) and provide grants from moneys in the Fund. There may be costs to OAG to operate the fund, but the costs are indeterminate as they depend on the grant criteria and procedures established by OAG. However, at least one finance staff at \$108,695 per year will be required. A budget amendment would be needed to appropriate dollars to this fund to make it
