4. Title: Elections; voter registration; lists of registered voters; provided to registered voters.

5. Summary: Provides that the Department of Elections must provide the lists for their districts to any registered voter of the Commonwealth for a reasonable charge not to exceed its actual cost incurred in supplying the requested records.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of the bill is indeterminate. However, no fiscal impact is expected to the general fund, as the bill provides that the Department of Elections may charge registered voters that request a list of voters in their district a reasonable charge not to exceed its actual cost incurred to supply the requested records.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections, State Board of Elections, and localities (General Registrars and Electoral Boards).
