4. Title: Health insurers; duty of in-network providers to submit claims, prohibited practices.

5. Summary: Current law requires any in-network provider who provides health care services to a covered patient to submit its claim to the health insurer for the healthcare services in accordance with the terms of the applicable provider agreement or as permitted under applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This bill provides that any violations of this section shall be subject to enforcement provisions of the Virginia Consumer Protection Act.
