4. Title: Parole; exception to the limitation on the application of parole statutes; felony marijuana.

- 5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to make recommendations regarding the resentencing of persons convicted of marijuanarelated offenses committed prior to July 1, 2021, who remain incarcerated for such conviction or a combination of such convictions or remain on community supervision for such conviction or a combination of such convictions. A report of DCJS's recommendations must be submitted to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 1, 2022 and posted on the General Assembly's website.

- **8.
